**Indiana Privacy Addendum** 

This Indiana Privacy Addendum ("Addendum") supplements the Grant Thornton **Privacy Statement** ("Privacy Statement") and contains the disclosures required under the Indiana

Consumer Data Protection Act ("ICDPA"). For individuals who are Indiana residents

("consumers"), the ICDPA requires certain disclosures about the collection and use of

Personal Data. Indiana residents have the right to exercise certain rights regarding their

Personal Data as detailed in this Addendum.

What is Personal Data

For Indiana residents, the term "Personal Data" (Personal Information) is defined as information linked or reasonably linkable to an identified or identifiable individual, and does not include de-identified data, aggregate data, or publicly available information as defined in the ICDPA. All other capitalized terms have the same meanings as given in the Privacy Statement.

**Uses of Your Personal Data** 

This Addendum provides disclosures with respect to the categories of Personal Data that Grant Thornton collects through the Site and our Services, the business or commercial purposes for which such Personal Data is processed, the categories of Personal Data that may have been shared with third parties and the categories to which those third parties belong. Grant Thornton does not have actual knowledge that it sells the Personal Data of individuals under 16 years of age. Grant Thornton does not sell Personal Data as "sale" is defined under the ICDPA.

# Your Personal Data may be Shared

Grant Thornton does not sell Personal Data to third parties. However, to the extent we engage in processing of Personal Data for purposes of targeted advertising or share Personal Data, you have the right to opt out of the sharing of Personal Data. ## **Rights**

If you are an Indiana resident who has provided Personal Data to Grant Thornton, you have the right to request the following, subject to any statutory limitations or exceptions. ICDPA provides that a consumer may make a rights request once per year free of charge. However, where requests from a consumer are manifestly unfounded, excessive, or repetitive, there may be a reasonable fee to cover the administrative costs of complying with the request, or we may decline to act on the request.

 Confirm whether we process your Personal Data and provide access to and/or a copy of that Personal Data

- Correct inaccuracies in your Personal Data
- Delete your Personal Data
- Opt out of targeted advertising, sale of your Personal Data or profiling in furtherance of decisions that produce legal or similarly significant effects concerning the consumer, as applicable.

# **How to Submit a Rights Request**

#### Verification

We will need to verify your identity to respond to a rights request, except for requests to opt-out of sharing. If you have an account with us that is password-protected, we may verify your identity through our existing authentication practices for your account. If you do not have an account with us, we may request from you two data points or more of Personal Data to verify your identity depending on the nature of the request. Where you request specific pieces of Personal Data, we may also request a signed declaration under penalty of perjury to attest to/verify your identity.

### **Responses to Requests**

Grant Thornton will respond to requests as required by applicable law consistent with statutory requirements. In the case of a request to delete Personal Data, we may use a two-step process for online requests to delete where you must first, submit the request to delete and then second, separately confirm that you want your Personal Data deleted.

We reserve the right to deny a request in the following circumstances and where otherwise permitted by Indiana law:

- your identity cannot be verified according to the level required or
- the request is manifestly unfounded, excessive, or repetitive, consistent with ICDPA.

# **Appeal Process**

If we decline to act on your request, we will inform you and provide instructions for how you may appeal our decision. You may initiate an appeal by submitting a request through the **contact methods below** within a reasonable period of time after your receipt of our decision. Within sixty (60) days of receiving an appeal, Grant Thornton will inform you of any action taken or not taken in response to the appeal. If we deny your appeal, you may contact the **Indiana Attorney General** to submit a complaint.

#### **No Discrimination**

Grant Thornton will not discriminate against you in the event you exercise any of the rights under Indiana privacy law. We will not deny goods or services, charge different prices or rates for goods and services, or provide a different level or quality of goods or services where you exercise your rights. However, if you do not provide the Personal Data necessary for the goods or services, we may deny them and where we offer a voluntary loyalty program, terms for goods or services may vary.
