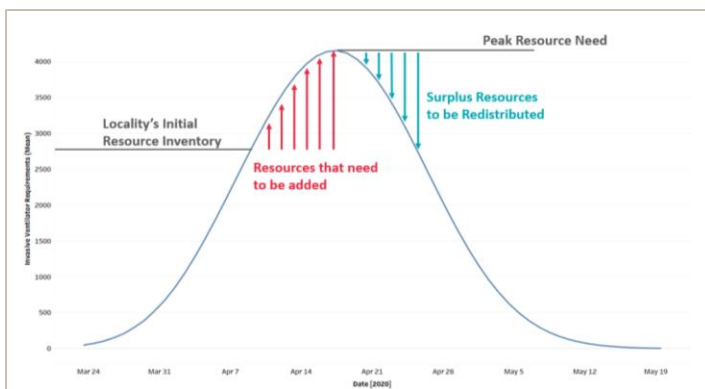


Managing PPE, ventilators, and testing supplies

It then compares resource usage with current inventories to provide a recommended redistribution of resources from areas with sufficient inventory to areas that have the greatest unmet need at the time. This reallocation of resources leverages the full capacity of available resources to best meet emerging pandemic-related needs.



Project availability of surplus resources from areas that have hit their peak requirements to localities whose needs are still growing or unmet

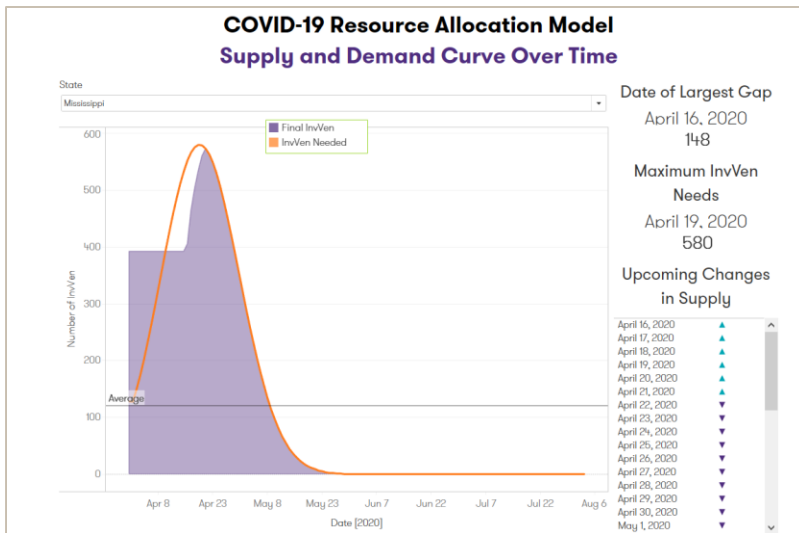
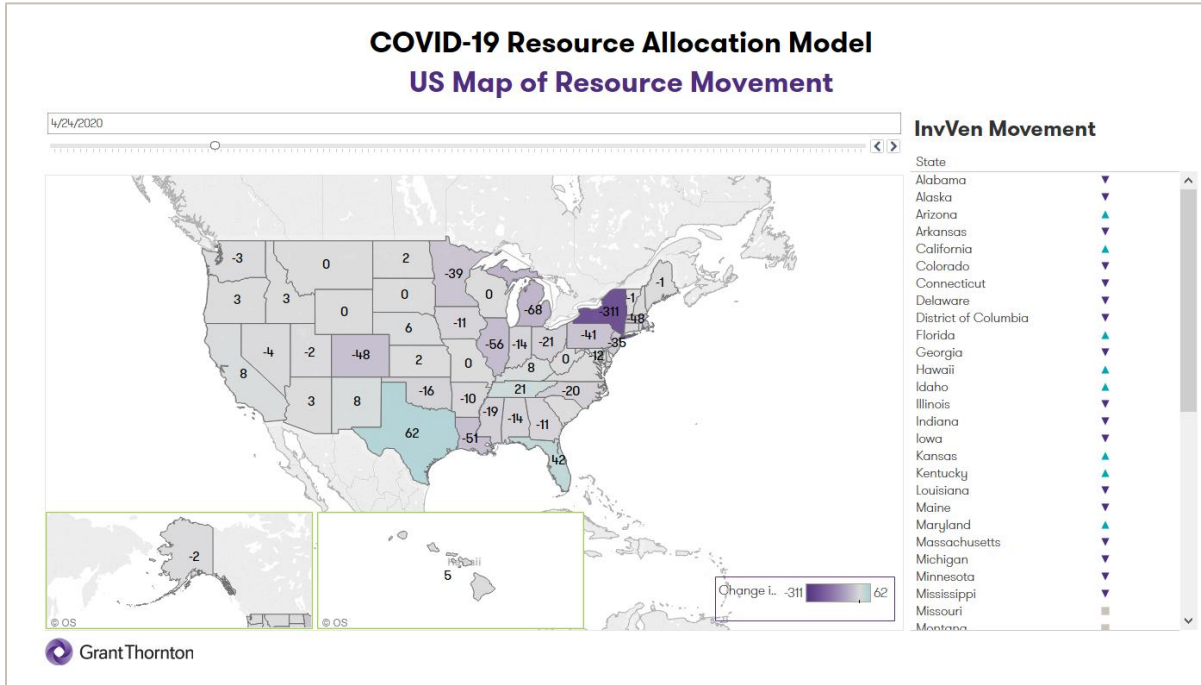
